Tema: U rešenju, bela figura prvim potezom napušta polje P i omogućava crnoj figuri F da pređe preko tog polja. Nakon toga bela baterija matira zatvaranjem linije crne figure F.

Od direktora turnira Milana Velimirovića, primio sam 35 problema od 26 autora, bez njihovih imena. Pošto je jedan autor mogao da učestvuje sa samo jednim radom, bio sam prinuđen da eliminišem i neke odlične kompozicije, što se naročito odnosi na brojeve 1004 i 1033 komponovanih od strane autora prvonagrađenog problema. Kvalitet 12 izdvojenih problema je vrlo dobar, obzirom na karakter turnira i kratak rok. Moja odluka je sledeća:



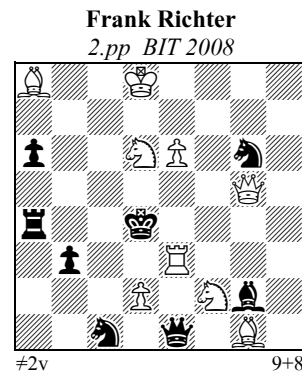
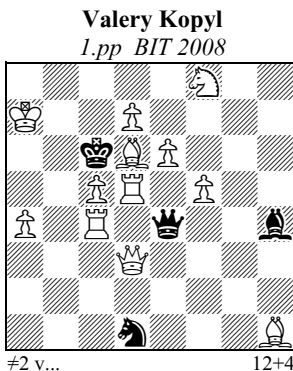
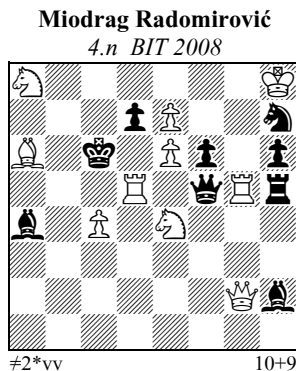
**1. nagrada – br.1005, Marjan Kovačević, Srbija.** Neobično lep i sadržajan mehanizam u savršenoj konstrukciji, sa samo pet belih figura! Izborom figure koja će da kreira bateriju uzimanjem na d5 belu omogućava i tematske odbrane jednom od crnih topova i koristi njihov kritični prelaz preko polja c3 i c4 (pri čemu je secište na b3 genijalan konstruktivni detalj). Izvanredan je vizuelni efekat koji se time ostvaruje, tj. ceo sistem desno od d-linije, sukcesivno se "projektuje" na levu stranu. Odbrana 1...c4, na koju se menjaju tri mata, veoma je bitna u celom konceptu jer omogućava belom da, povratom svojih baterijskih figura, isključe crne topove i u suprotnom smeru.
